Dit sal baie gou verlep.”



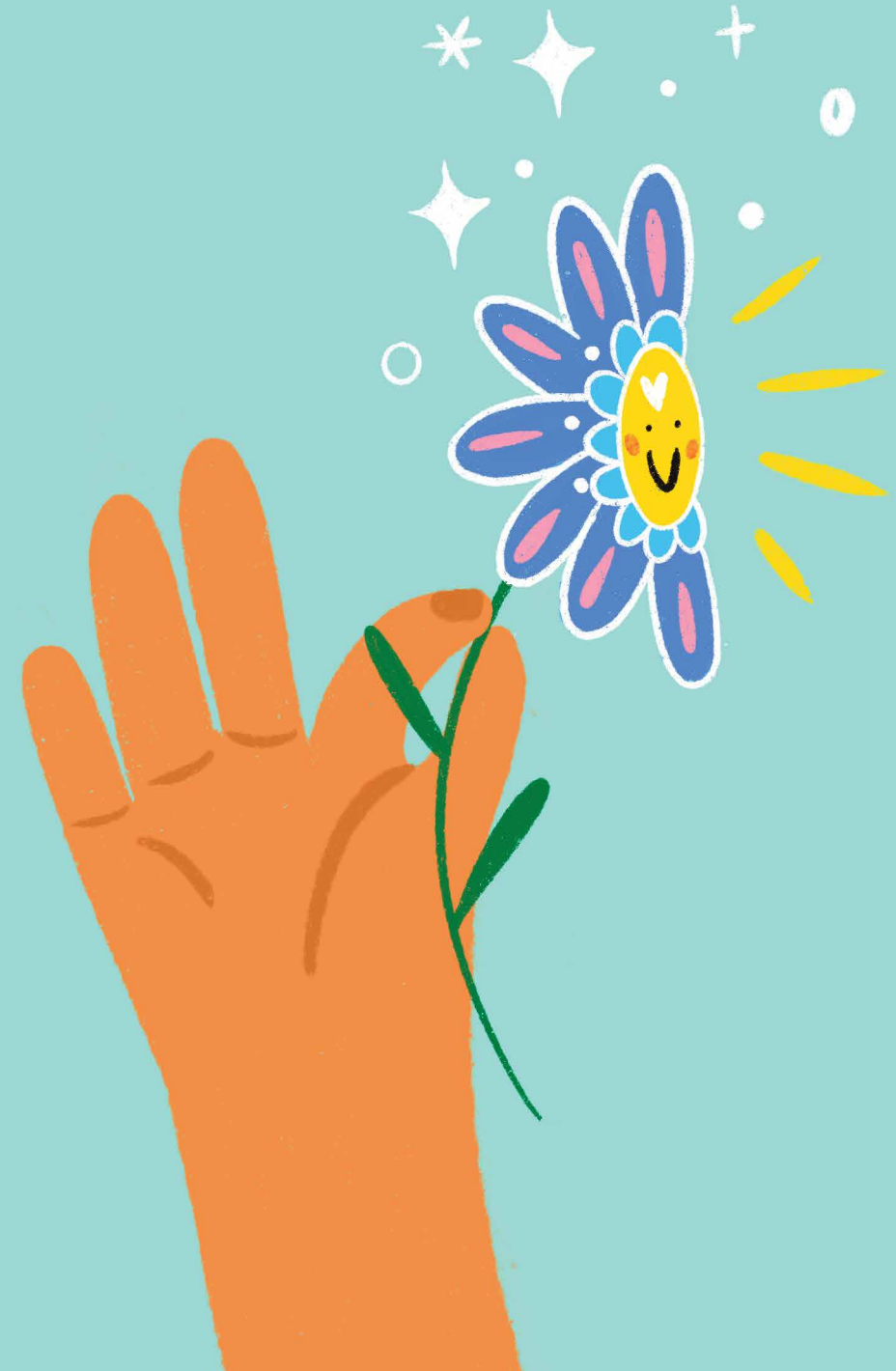


“Ek sal nie die blomme pluk
