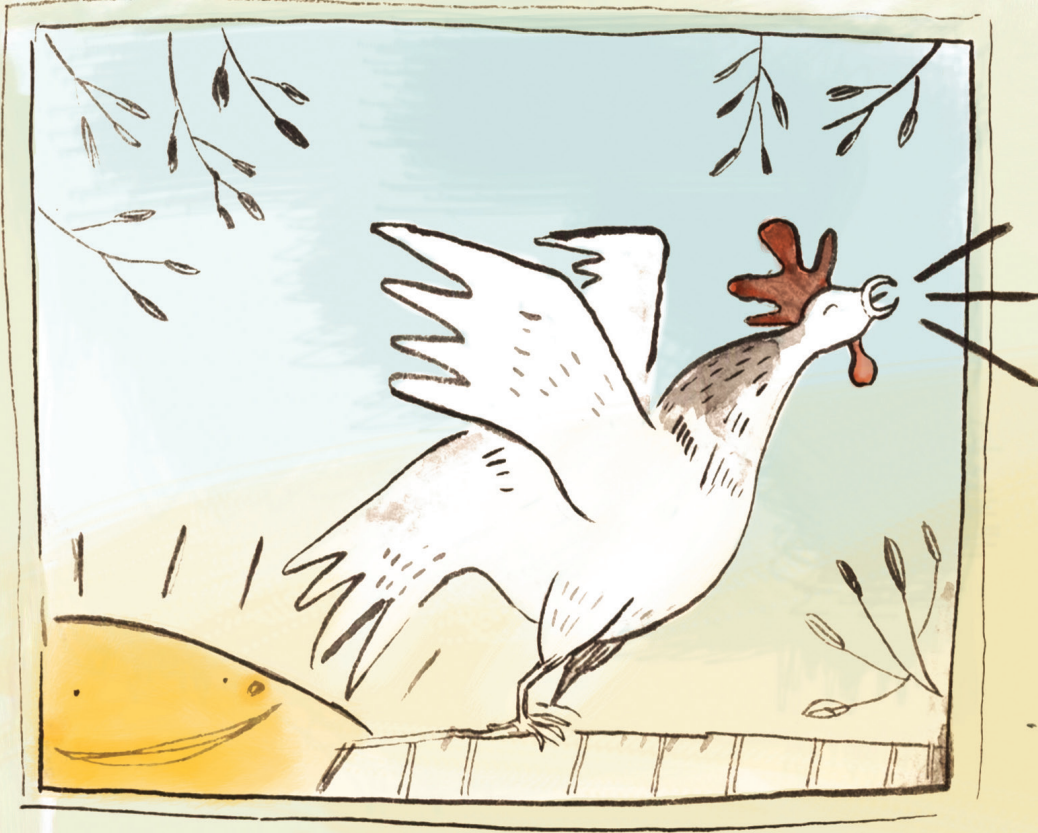

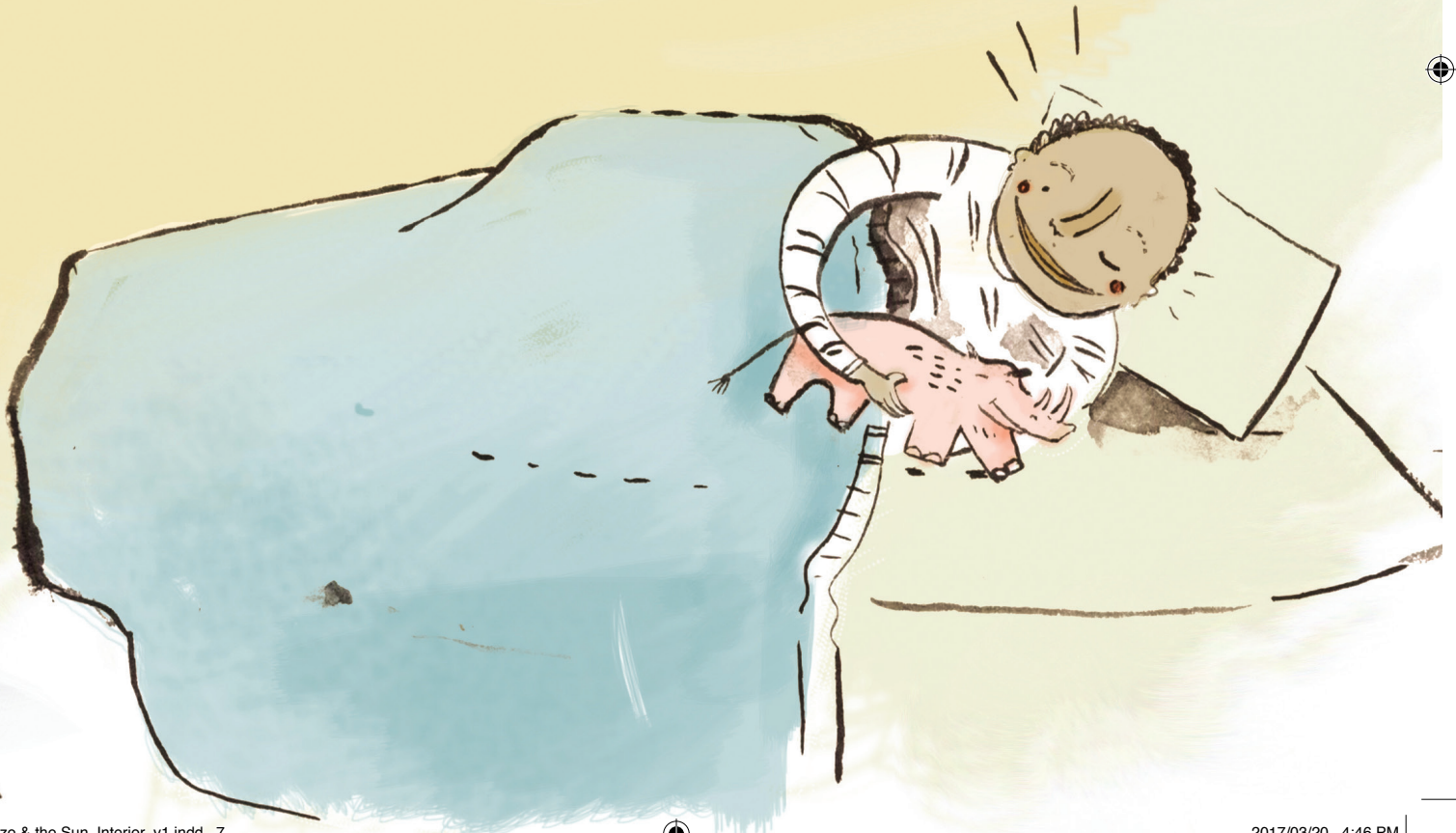




The morning sun creeps over the horizon

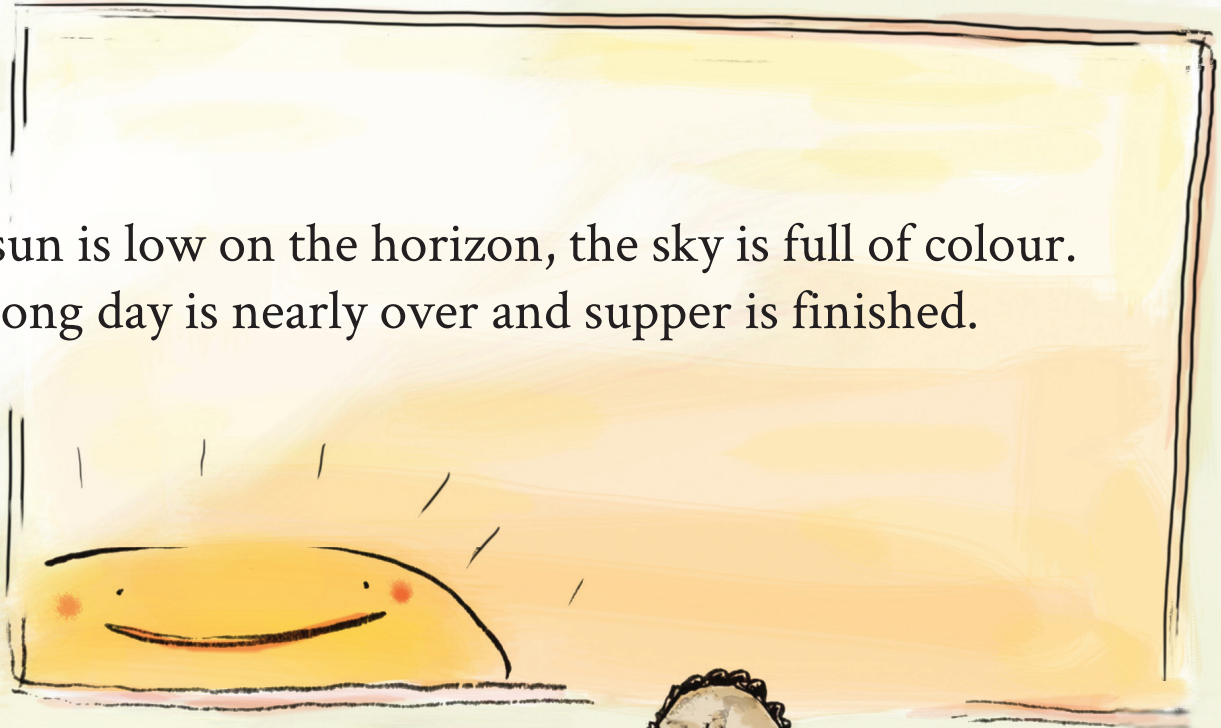

Can you?





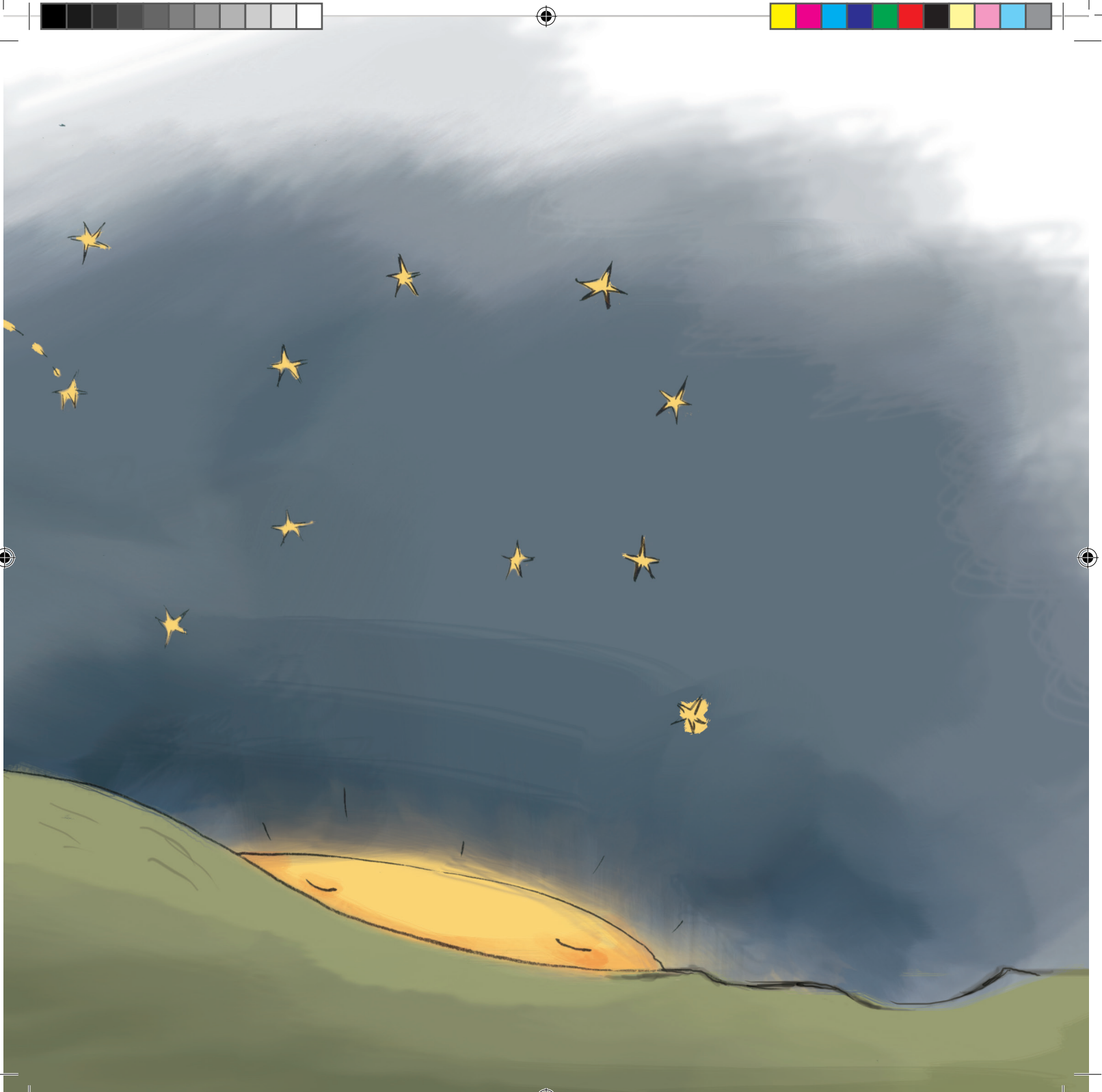


The sun has done her work for the day
