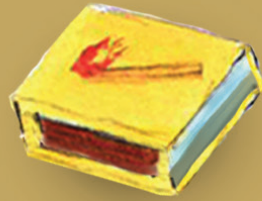

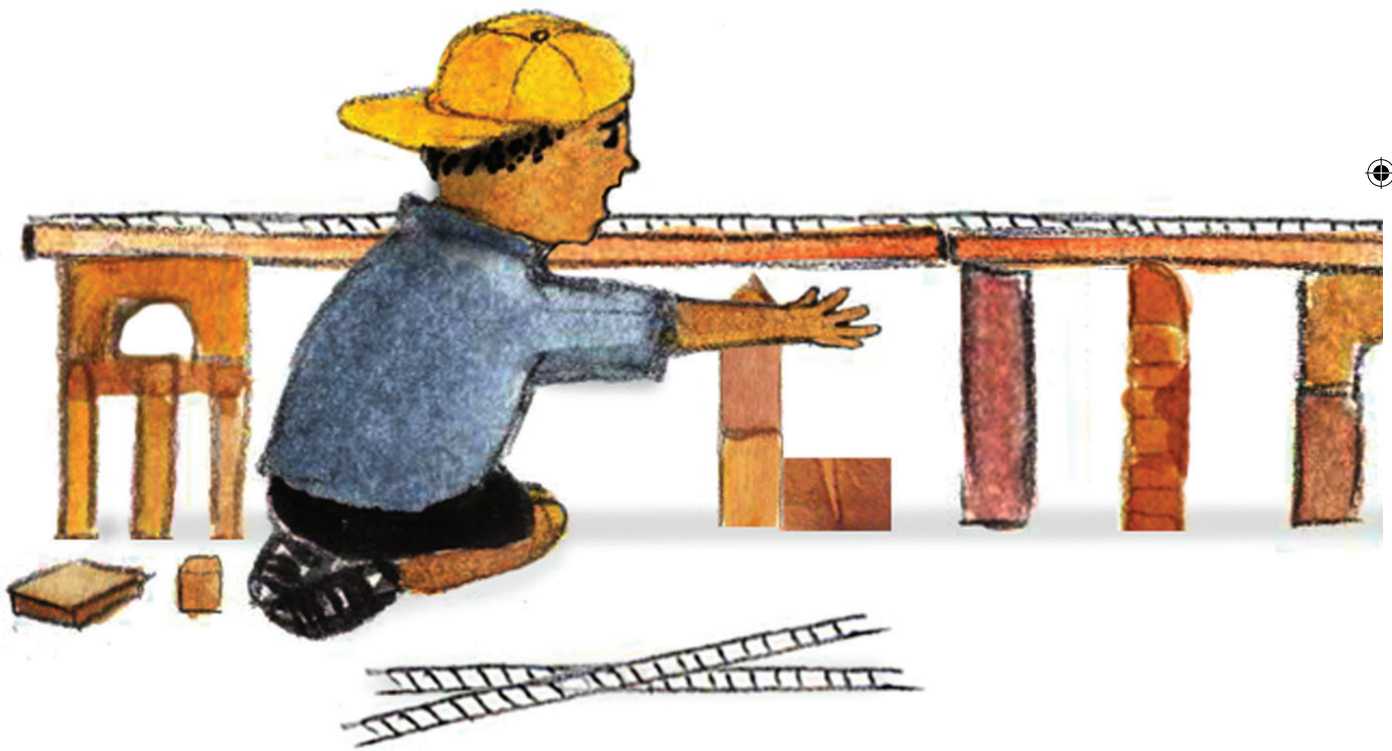

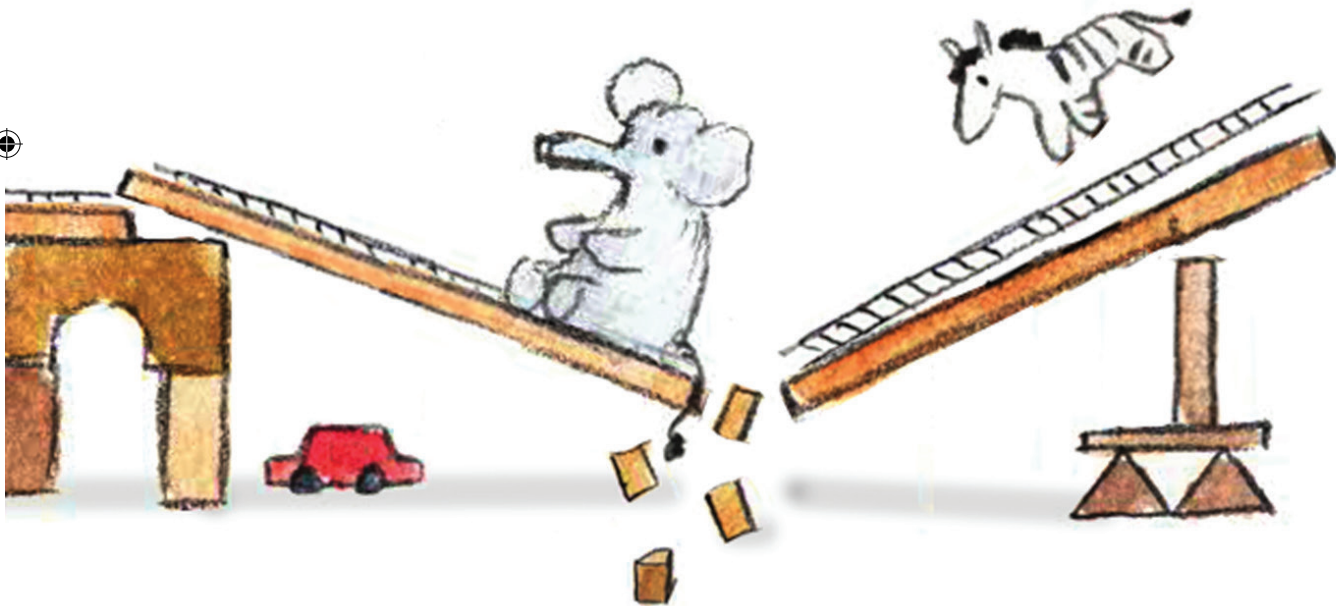

Nuwe goed en ou goed.









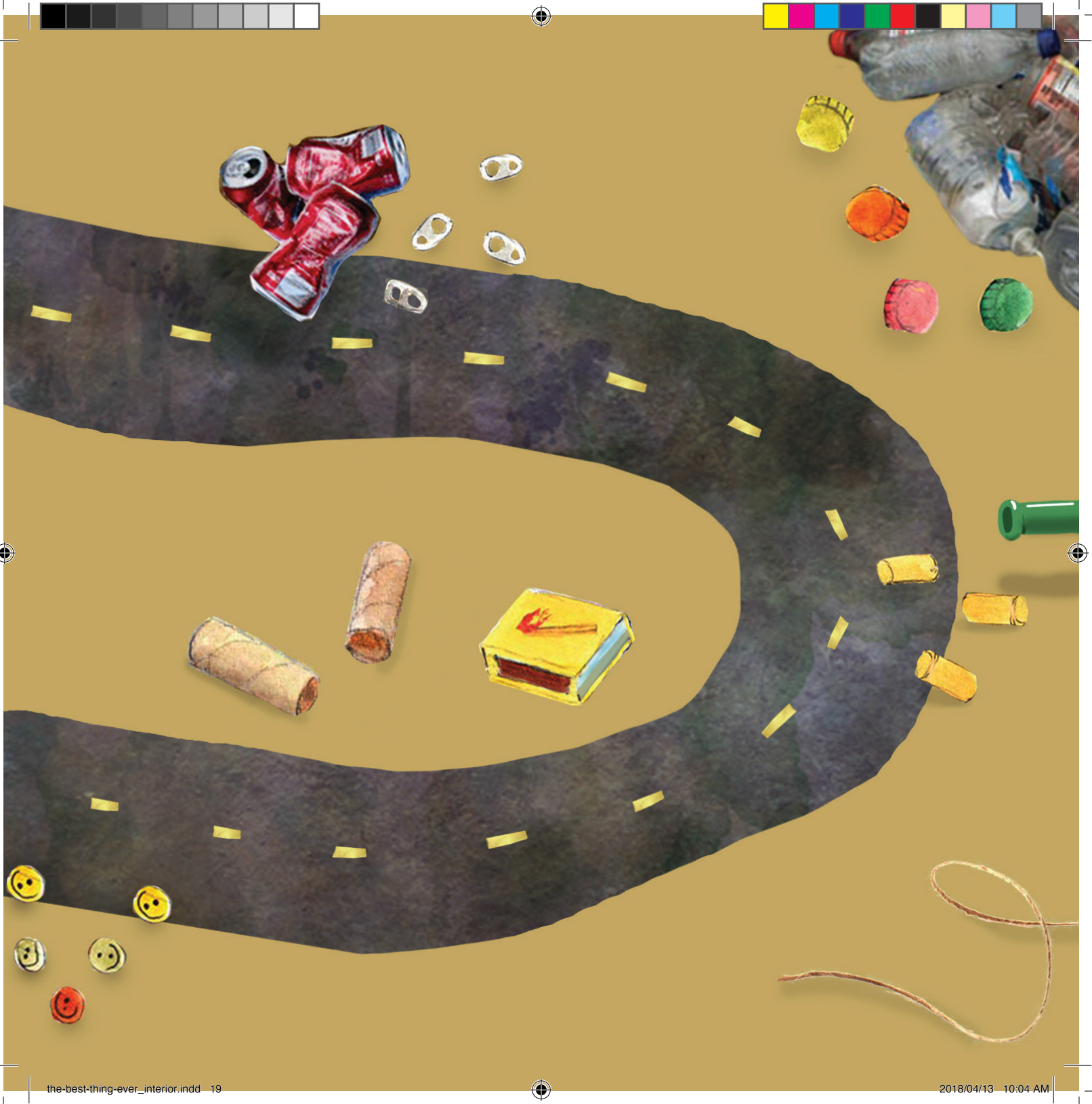
Muzi het 'n nuwe idee om die beste
